FAQ COMPOSITE WALL CLADDING BOARDS

Q: Where can I get the composite wall cladding boards?

A : Composite boards are currently available at the following stores in Canada: Rona (in 3 colors) and Reno Depot (1 color available).

Q: Which colors are available?

A: 3 colors are available at Rona (Mahogany, Redwood and Charcoal) and 1 color at Reno Depot (Walnut).

Q: What is the warranty on composite wall cladding boards?

A: A 25-year limited warranty on wall boards products against any manufacturing defect.

Q : Can the boards be installed by the consumer himself?

A: Yes, although installation by a recognized contractor is recommended.

Q : Can the wall cladding boards be cut?

A: It is not recommended to cut composite boards; a joint molding has been designed for this purpose. If not, you will need to apply a treated wood sealer to the cut ends.

Q: Is an installation guide available?

Q: Should special attention be given to expansion or contraction?

A: Thanks to our specially designed moldings, expansion or contraction will be done inside the molding trim so expansion or contraction will not be apparent.

Q: How can I minimize expansion or contraction?

A: Using an locking screw in the bottom hole of the aluminum clips: only one locking clip in the middle of the panel will be needed to minimize expansion or contraction.

Q : Can a different window molding be used?

A: Yes, but always allow enough space (1/8 in) between the composite cladding and your window trim to leave room for expansion.
